Chamber Names First Executive Director

Pamela Hoffman honored and excited to assume role in Chamber leadership

Longtime Aliso Viejo resident, community advocate and Chamber member Pamela Hoffman has been named the first ever Executive Director for the Aliso Viejo Chamber of Commerce

As a new leader of the Chamber, Hoffman stated

she is ready for the challenge of heading the nearly four-year-old organization by continuing to work hard for Chamber members and the community she calls home.

"As a 24-year-resident of Aliso Viejo, I am very excited to be named the first Executive Director of the Aliso Viejo Chamber of Commerce," Hoffman said. "I look forward to continuing to work side by side with the Board of Directors, business owners and residents of Aliso Viejo, as we continue to grow the Chamber, and allow others to see why Aliso Viejo is such a great place to live and work."

Hoffman's hiring was voted on and approved at the January Director's meeting. President Beau Nokes is looking forward to Hoffman's leadership in her new role.

"Having Pam Hoffman as our full-time Executive Director will make it much easier for members to communicate with the chamber and get their needs taken care of," Nokes said. "Pam brings with her a wealth of managerial experience from the business world, and even before becoming two years I echo the sentiments of Eric and full-time, she made sure things ran smoothly-no small feat with an allvolunteer board.




